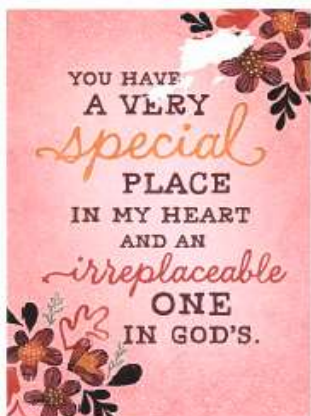

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**In order to maintain eligibility for TEFAP, all recipient agencies must:**

1. Display the "And Justice for All" poster in plain sight. If you need a poster, please contact Michele: 631-582-3663 ext. 134.
2. Distribute the new Written Notice of Beneficiary Rights to all regular clients as they fill out the Universal Entitlement Form. For one-time only clients, it is acceptable to explain these rights and show the displayed Notice. (NEW)
3. Attend an annual Civil Rights training. Trainings are added to all regularly scheduled workshops.
4. **Food Pantries ONLY – must have clients sign the Universal Entitlement form.** This form is for your use only. Do not send it back to LI Cares.
5. Retain delivery records/universal entitlement forms for a minimum of 4 years.

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## Attention – All HPNAP Agencies

HPNAP has decided to extend the current HPNAP 2018-2019 (11/1/2018-10/31/2019) for an additional eight (8) months 11/1/2018 – 6/30/2020). What does this mean to you?

1. All current HPNAP food grant agencies will receive additional funding to cover the new grant period for both lines of credit:
  - a. Donated Menu – HPNAP SMF (Shared Maintenance Fee)
  - b. HPNAP Menu – purchased food items.
2. All current HPNAP agencies will be asked to sign a new HPNAP Agreement to cover the new time period & Quick Renewal Form (11/1/2019 – 6/30/2020).
3. All eligible agencies not currently receiving HPNAP food funds will be sent an application in late August to be eligible for HPNAP funding for the period 11/1/2019-6/30/2020.

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## TEFAP MENU: PRETTY PEAS RECIPE

### Indian Yellow Split Pea Dal

Makes 4 servings

Dal (dahl or dhal) is an easy, adaptable, popular vegetarian dish from Southeast Asia. Depending on the region, dal is made from split or dried peas, lentils, or beans and a variety of spices and can be served as a meal or side dish or more liquid can be added to make into a soup.

#### Ingredients

- 1 cup yellow split peas (uncooked)
- 2 cups water (or vegetable broth)
- 1 teaspoon turmeric
- 1/4 teaspoon cayenne or 1/2 tsp chili powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 tablespoon margarine or butter
- 1 onion (diced)
- 1 clove of garlic, diced (optional)
- 1 1/2 teaspoon cumin (whole seeds or ground)
- 2 whole cloves
- Dash pepper (to taste)



#### Instructions

1. In a large pot, combine the uncooked yellow split peas and the water or vegetable broth, and bring to a slow simmer on the stove.
2. Add the turmeric and cayenne or chili powder.
3. Cover and cook for at least 30 minutes, until the yellow split peas are fully cooked, stirring occasionally.
4. You can also continue to cook your dal for an additional 10 to 15 minutes, if you prefer, to allow the yellow split peas to break up and have a smoother texture.
5. Either way, once the split peas are almost done, in a separate large skillet or frying pan, heat the onion, garlic, cumin, and clove in the margarine. Cook for 4 to 6 minutes, until onion, is soft.
6. Add the onion, garlic and spices mixture to the split peas, and allow to simmer for at least 5 more minutes.
7. Add a dash of pepper and salt.
8. Enjoy hot with rice, bread or on its own in a soup bowl!
